1. Curren ran the drinks so that was good

  2. Script sales- \$34,636 cash, \$4,000 in card
  3. Classes will get solid accounts once tickets are hoʻoia ʻia.
  4. Papa Alakaʻi won the decoration contest
  5. Sesame will send out an update once scripts are counted
- iii. Complements on the food!!!
- iv. Nā Leo Kālele was really impressed about how everything ran.
- v. We had about 3,700 people according to wrist band count
- vi. We made out well for funds this year- Silent & live auction
- vii. Huliau Foundation Waste Station- Impressed with the event
  1. Next year will have a list of certified compostable material
  2. Waste stations for vendors
  3. Before Hoʻomau, a vendor meeting to sort out the trash & recycles
    - a. This year a grant covered the 4 stations
    - b. Normally would be \$2000 for 4 stations
  4. Report shows how many pounds of each type, percentages of all
    - a. Need to cut down on clear cup and utensils because only so much we can do
    - b. cut down on 69% of trash this year
    - c. Kūpaʻa Farm takes the compost
    - d. Recycle bottles etc \$ went to the organization- perhaps we can coordinate that next year to get HI5 monies etc.
    - e. Huliau takes all food waste and compostables
  5. Live Mālama ʻĀina; nice to show the kaiāulu
    - a. We want to encourage the Huliau Foundation model so Trina will send out the signs from the bins to perpetuate the manaʻo.
    - b. Mahalo e Kumu Kaleimaile for translating the signs so they would be in ʻōlelo Hawaiʻi.

- ix. IDEA for collecting \$- ask the makua to pay up front & pay monies to help with food vendor booth.
