E. ‘Aha Kauleo – 1. Clarification for DOE that GE exceptions are not required for students who want to be in Kaiapuni program. They are guaranteed a spot.

2. Kaiapuni Licensure – 1) if already a certified English teacher, need to take 490 class and pass test to get Kaiapuni certified. 2) Without bachelor’s will need to enter bachelors of Education at UH, they will infuse HAW & HWST classes to that program for Kaiapuni certification. 3) With certain bachelors and HAW490, can enter the Masters two year program for Kaiapuni certification.

3. Assessment testing – 3&4 math and language arts were done in OH with high participation rates, website shows results. Science test was piloted last year, will be set this year. First Natives in “America” to create our own exam, which was done by teachers, Haw Language experts, content experts. Still waiting for approval of waiver to exempt from English tests, currently need to push for opt-out.
