IV. MO‘OLELO NĀ KUMU & ALAKA‘I

A. Kekaulike – *Call in by Kumu Kapolei*

-Currently 39 Kaiapuni students enrolled in 9-12. Kaiapuni is growing so there is a need for more Kumu. Currently and for the past 20 years, there have only been 2 kumu positions funded through the state HLIP office, now OHE, both kumu working to advocate for a part-time kumu as this may be, may is more realistic than with school's budget. OHE is putting pressure on schools to absorb 1 position at school level so that state level position can be used to up other school sites on Maui, as OHE budget has not necessarily increased. Kaiapuni Kumu positions are not currently counted in Kekaulike's school budget as determined by Weighted Student Formula,

-Class sizes: P9-12, P10-10, P11-10, P12-7

-Kahele has begun teaching Haw 202 at Kekaulike. Partnered with Kahikina o ka Lā at UHMC. Haumāna can earn up to 16 college credits. Maika'i!

-Kekaulike's over all school enrollment as a whole has increased this year. Now at 1115 students. -Aha hemo meeting was provided at Open house by Kumu Kapolei to explain to makua how it works and what is required.

-Kili is on SCC

E. Kalama – *Kumu Kiani*

a. *ipad rollout – Provided by Digital Promise & Verizon for all students and faculty to encourage using technology for education purposes. This is the 2nd year, last year was a slow, late start. But students are starting to familiarize and utilize. Kumu U'i is currently utilizing as she is currently away in Alaska helping 'ohana.*

e. *kaiapuni volleyball – Just had a parent meeting, good showing, with 40 students interested. Kumu Kiani is heading the teams. Mon & Fri are practices at Eddie Tam. Tues & Thurs are games. Begins end of Oct, beginning of Nov. All in 'Ōlelo Hawai'i. Enrich grants allows this to be free to all students.*

i. *fair opening ceremony – 'Okekopa 6, call time is at 5:30pm. Consist of Oli and Pule from 6:20 – 6:30 on mainstage.*

o. *na mele/uniforms – Getting practice time with all 3 papas. New uniforms.*



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- Kaiapuni has 65 students total, 20 is the smallest class. Kalama's total enrollment has gone up to over 800 students. Will need more Kumu next year
- SCC currently has no Kaiapuni Representation
- new Principle Tim Shim, has been VP for the past 2 years. He is very supportive of Kaiapuni.
- Joy Au is the VP this year, and she is also a Kaiapuni makua.
- Open House will be Aug 30 for 6th grade – Kaiapuni only participates on this night. Aug 31 is for 7 & 8 grade. 5:15pm Welcome in cafeteria, 5:30pm – 6:30pm revolving meet & greet. 6:30pm – 7:15pm Spaghetti dinner provided by school. Book fair will be open from 5pm – 8pm

I. Pā'ia

a. Papa Mālaa'o Update – Hālāwai & Rep

The new reps are Tatiana Piena & Alexis Kahue. Good showing, about 20 ohana.

e. Papa 4 huaka'i O'ahu budget cut

Cut 5,600\$ of state funds that covers bus transportation at Huaka'i. State office is changing how they distribute \$\$, instead of lump sum, they are now requesting budget according to Kaiapuni standards. Po'o Kumu provides the budget to submit to OHE Kaiapuni Office. Kau'i Sang is head of OHE, and Kalehua Krug is head of the Kaiapuni sect of OHE.

Cost is approximately 500-600\$ per keiki.

Alternative options to cut cost?... Depends on class and funds... Kumu and Makua discussion, but final decisions are up to Kumu.

o. Lā Māla

Good work was done on Saturday. Plan to have once a month so different makua can make it. Sesame is paid by School Garden Network to incorporate Māla for classes for whichever kumu wants to participate. Fridays for 30 minutes.

-Kumu Ku'uipo report – Open House is Wednesday 8/24 from 5:00pm – 6:30pm. Leka has been sent to all students.

-Kumu Kalele is the kumu for Papa 1 for the first quarter. Still need to find a replacement, and we also need more Kaiapuni subs.

- 2 PM, 3 P1, 2 P2, 3 P3, 2 P4, 2 P5 – Kaiapuni is growing, need more space.

-Kumu Kapeka is full time sub for P5, mirroring Kumu Leinani. Introducing English.

-SCC, Trina and Kanoë are reps, good Kaiapuni representation

-New PCNC, Laverne

-Fun run October 5, need volunteers

-Water dispenser currently paid for by Friends of Pā'ia, receiving 3 more months from Menehune. Will discuss how to pay for water at the September SCC meeting. There is currently a filtration system, but need someone to sanitize and refill bottles.

-Uniforms, Po'o Kumu will send out another survey

-Pumpkin Carving October 27. Barnes & Noble will be there

- 30 students at Pūnana Leo O Maui

- Currently cross training kumu with Pūnana Leo O Lāhaina

E. Lā 'Ohana Plans – quarterly?

I. Kula Hou – Pu'unēnē - Kahele



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- need a process to address issue to community
- DOE pushing back on this idea, as they are currently using as offices, perhaps swap with Pā'ia.
- ask Aha Kauleo to support by writing letters to DOE & BOE for process to find a site
- Are we looking to move everyone from Pā'ia or have some students and Kumu stay at Pā'ia to allow for enrollment expansion?
- Leila needs lots of encouragement, creative solutions of where DOE office will move
- Community voice can make things happen if its strong
- Need to engage conversations with Broader community
- Need data of who wants to go and who wants to stay at Pā'ia.

O. Aha Kauleo – meeting occurs 4 times a year. There is a teacher, parent, and administrative rep from every school. Can be a bridge between all Maui Kaiapuni. * Makua rep is decided by the school, not NLK. Pā'ia Po'o Kumu will be submitting a request for nominations and then to vote. Kalama will need to work on their selection process for their makua rep this year also.

Some topics at the meetings are... - teacher licenses - Po'o Kumus come together to talk
- professional development opportunities – currently not enough access for Kaiapuni
- budget - geographic exceptions -legislative
- lots of #s, assessments – teacher committee - overall advisory
- professional expert committees (HW Lang, HW Studies – just met to go over last years tests) It is good that Kaiapuni has our own testing and development for our keiki

*Should create another way for Maui to bridge all Kaiapuni (O Maui, Lāhaina, Hana)
