Pūnana Leo o Maui

- Called to order at 6:05 p.m.
- Mo‘olelo Kākau ‘Ōlelo
- Deferred to next meeting
- Motion to accepted projected budget for FY2017 by Darryll Naeole. 2nd by Ku‘ulei
- Mo‘olelo Nā Kumu
 - Kekahulike
 - Papa alaka‘i meeting on Saturday and field trip coming up.
 - Kalama
 - Bell schedule adjustment. Tuesdays, school will begin at 7:58 instead of 7:50 a.m. to stay in line with regulations
 - Oct. 27 and 28 Fright Night
 - Student’s meal status ends on Sept. 19th so be sure to renew it if you need to.

 - Pā‘ia Elementary
 - Fun Run on Wednesday, Oct. 4. Packets going home tomorrow.

 - Kīhei bus routes have new stops added and Kahului bus route has stayed the same even though there was some discussions that it would be elsewhere
 - A grandparent told Po‘o Kumu Lu‘uwai that some kids at the Paukūkalo bus stop were left unattended and were jumping off the roof of the bathroom so parents should be aware.
